Step 1 - Go to www.kroger.com/communityrewards

Step 2a - If you are already an online Kroger customer click the "Sign In" button.

Use your email address and password to proceed to the sign in.
Enter NPO number 12134 or select Communities In Schools from list and click on confirm.

Step 2b - If you are not an online Kroger customer click the "Create an Account" button and have your Kroger Plus Card handy.

Sign up for a Kroger Rewards Account by entering zip code, clicking on favorite store, entering your email address and creating a password, agreeing to the terms and conditions

You will then get a e-mail message from Kroger and then you will know your online account is set up.

Go back to www.kroger.com/communityrewards and click on "Enroll Now" button.

Click on Edit Kroger Community Rewards information and input your Kroger Plus card number - it is the number on the back of your card.

Update or confirm the rest of your account information on the Account Summary page including under Community Rewards. There you click the "Enroll" button and enter your name and address and hit the "Save" button.

Now enter NPO number 12134 or select Communities In Schools of Clark County from list and click on confirm and click the "Enroll" button.
Then you can sign out.

Step 2c - If you are not an online Kroger customer and you use your phone number at check-out instead of a Kroger Plus Card.

Call 800-576-4377 select option 4 to get your Kroger Plus card number.

Then go to **Step 2b**.
